

RULES & GUIDELINES - GRADUATE RESEARCH SHOWCASE

- Last date for registering (name, department, email id and a probable title for the poster is required) is April 3rd, 2009. The right of accepting the entries after the due date is reserved with the executive board of Council of Graduate Students
- Size of the poster should be around 36 inches x 42 inches (Width X Length)
- Limit only one entry per person
- Posters should be a single sheet (small sized sheets put together as a poster is not allowed)
- Posters can be laminated but please do not stick any hard material as foam or card board to support the poster. It makes difficult to put them on boards for displaying purpose
- No laptops or other types of presentation material except posters will be allowed
- Posters should be displayed on allocated boards by 9:00 AM for the morning session and by 1:00 PM for the afternoon session
- Posters should be taken off by 12:30 PM for the morning session and by 4:30 PM for the afternoon session
- If the posters are not taken off by the given time, CGS will not be responsible for any loss or damages
- Participants can be present in the room while judging is in process. Once the judging procedure is over, participants can explain and demonstrate their posters to the general audience
- The showcase will be open for public from 11AM-12PM for the morning session and from 3PM-4PM for the afternoon session
- Final decision in case of any objections or disputes is reserved with the executive board .
